- 2. Pre-spray areas to be cleaned and allow a dwell time of 5-10 minutes.



- 3. Agitate with brush or by other means.
- 4. Wait for 20-30 minutes to allow carpet to dry.

Vacuum carpet thoroughly.



Spot Cleaning

- 1. Spray directly onto spots to be cleaned and allow a dwell time of 5-10 minutes.
- 2. Agitate with brush or by other means
- 3. Wait for 20-30 minutes to allow carpet to dry.
- 4. Vacuum carpet thoroughly.



Extraction Cleaning

- 1. Pre-mix 1 part of product with 32 parts of water in the extraction machine.
- 2. Extract in normal way.
- 4. Accelerate drying with air-moving units as needed.
- 5. After carpet has dried, routine vacuuming is sufficient.
